NAVY RELEASES NEW ECONOMIC IMPACT REPORT FOR HAMPTON ROADS AREA

NORFOLK, VA (NRMA) – Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic has released the fiscal year (FY) 2016 (Oct. 1, 2015 through Sept. 30, 2016) Department of the Navy impact statistical data for the Hampton Roads area.

Total direct economic impact for the area in FY16 was \$12.3 billion, an increase of approximately \$1.56 billion over FY15. Annual payroll (military, civilian and contractors) saw an increase from \$8.9 billion to \$10.1 billion from FY15 to FY16. In addition, the procurement of goods and services saw an increase of nearly \$420 million, from \$1.67 billion in FY15 to \$2.09 billion in FY16.

The report captures the amount of direct capital infused into the local economies as a result of salaries, expenditures and contractual payment for services rendered in support of installation activities.
