Trial dates scheduled for Sailor/Marine charged in the death of Army Staff Sgt. Logan Melgar

NORFOLK, VA (NRMA) – General court-martial trial dates have been scheduled for U.S. Navy Chief Special Warfare Operator Tony E. Dedolph and U.S. Marine Corps Gunnery Sgt. Mario A. Madero-Rodriguez in conjunction with the death of Army Staff Sgt. Logan Melgar, who died June 4, 2017 while serving in Bamako, Mali.

Dedolph, scheduled March 23 through April 3, 2020, faces charges under the Uniform Code of Military Justice for Conspiracy, Assault; Conspiracy, Obstruction of Justice; Burglary; Felony Murder; Involuntary Manslaughter; Hazing; and Obstruction of Justice.

Madero-Rodriguez, scheduled April 20 through May 1, 2020, faces charges under the Uniform Code of Military Justice for Conspiracy, Assault; Conspiracy, Obstruction of Justice; Burglary; Felony Murder; Involuntary Manslaughter; Hazing; and False Official Statements.

Dedolph and Madero-Rodriguez made their initial appearances in Navy court for an Article 32 preliminary hearing on Aug. 5, 2019. If found guilty of felony murder, each could face life in federal prison without parole, reduction in rank to E-1, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and either a dishonorable or bad conduct discharge.

The Consolidated Disposition Authority for both cases is Rear Adm. Charles W. Rock, Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic.

The military justice system, like the civilian justice system, follows the principle of innocent until proven guilty.
