Navy Releases New Hampton Roads Area Economic Impact Report For Fiscal Year 2017

NORFOLK, VA (NRMA) – Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic released the fiscal year (FY) 2017 (Oct. 1, 2016 through Sept. 30, 2017) Department of the Navy impact statistical data for the Hampton Roads area.

The total direct economic impact for the area in FY17 was approximately \$13.4 billion, an increase of nearly \$600 million over FY16. Annual payroll (military, civilian and contractor) saw an increase from \$10.6 billion to \$11.4 billion from FY16 to FY17.

In FY17, the number of ships homeported in the Hampton Roads area increased to 68. This includes USS San Francisco (SSN 711), which was onboard Norfolk Naval Shipyard in FY17.

The report captures the amount of direct capital infused into the local Hampton Roads economy as a result of salaries, expenditures and contractual payment for services rendered in support of installation activities.
