



## CURRENT ACTIONS

### Current Actions

- Alternate drinking water source (bottled water) provided until a long-term solution is implemented
- Signage
- Website

### Future Actions: On-Base

- The Navy is evaluating options for long term solution
- Install additional treatment to existing treatment plant to reduce Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA) and Perfluorooctane Sulfonate (PFOS) concentrations to below Provisional Health Advisories (PHAs)
- Replacement of drinking water wells
- Purchase water from other sources

### Future Actions: Off-Base

- Off-base investigation of residential drinking water wells
  - Coordinate with federal, state, and city partners to plan public engagement and testing
  - Conduct public meetings
  - Provide alternate drinking water source (bottled water) as necessary
- Restoration of the groundwater will be addressed by the Navy Environmental Cleanup Program
  - Partnering with Virginia Department of Environmental Quality and US Environmental Protection Agency
