Capt. Lowther joins NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Norfolk from NAVSUP Weapon Systems Support, Mechanicsburg, Pa., where he served as deputy commander, ships and submarines. Prior to this, he served as the force supply officer for Commander, Submarine Force Atlantic, Norfolk, Va.
