

2021-2022 Requirements to Validate Hunting and Fishing Permits

- Hunting & Fishing Permits for NAS Oceana, Dam Neck Annex, and NALF Fentress can be purchased from Dam Neck Annex MWR facility The Dunes, Bldg 180 and NAS Oceana MWR ITT NEX Kiosk, Bldg 292. Permits are \$20 and can be purchased on Monday-Friday 0900-1700. <u>THERE ARE NO</u> <u>REFUNDS – PURCHASING A PERMIT AND SUBSEQUENT FAILURE TO COMPLETE A</u> <u>PROFICIENCY QUALIFICATION OR REQUIRED INDOCTRINATION TRAINING WILL</u> <u>RESULT IN YOUR INABILITY TO HUNT.</u>
- 2. Purchase of permit <u>does not</u> give authority to hunt or fish until you complete the following in accordance with COMNAVREG MIDLANT INSTRUCTIONs 11015.2, 11015.1, applicable Installation Instructions, and the NAS Oceana Deer Hunting Rules & Regulations supplemental document:
 - •Application
 - •Obtain State and Installation Permits
 - •Hunter Indoctrination (hunters only)
 - •Bow, Black Powder and/or Shotgun Slug Qualifications (hunters only)
 - Private Firearms registration for all personal firearms/weapons brought on Installation
 - Approved Hunter Safety Course (hunters only)

- 4. DO NOT FILL IN PERMIT! LEAVE PERMIT BLANK UNTIL YOU COMPLETE A HUNTING/ TRAPPING/ARCHERY/FISHING APPLICATION! Applications may be obtained at any scheduled required event (e.g., qualifications) or by setting up an appointment with Natural Resources personnel at the NAS Oceana NRC, Bldg. 78.
- **5.** In order to validate your permit at the above location you must provide the following items:
 - A. Appropriate Virginia State hunting or fishing licenses
 - B. Valid Proof of Identification (Federally issued photo. ID)
 - C. Valid State Hunter Safety Card (accept valid safety cards from all States), hunter only
 - D. Proof of completion of NAS Oceana Hunter Indoctrination and Qualification, hunters only
