Following designation as a Human Resources Officer, he served aboard USS HARRY S TRUMAN (CVN 75) as the Head of the Training Department.

Ashore, CDR Manaskie served as the Recruiting Operations Officer at Navy Recruiting District San Francisco, the Manpower and Personnel Director (N1) for the Center for Security Forces, and most recently as the Executive Assistant to the Director of Fleet Personnel Development and Allocation (N1) at U.S. Fleet Forces Command.
